

Understanding the Events Calendar (Patron View)

The Events Calendar has two basic views. [In House Registration Mode](#) and **Patron Mode**. They are similar in most ways.

The URL for the Patron Calendar is similar to the staff home page.

<http://Yourlibrary/lib/maintenance.asp> is the staff page

<http://Yourlibrary/lib/eventcalendar.asp> is the patron view.

This article focuses on the differences between the two modes.

Patron mode does not contain a filter for unpublished events in the search slider. Patron mode does not display events marked as private. Patron mode does have a Print View button, which enables a printer-friendly version of the page. The [RSS feed](#) in Patron mode is different. It shows the specific RSS for the calendar they are viewing. If they have created a custom filter, it will give them an RSS feed for their specific wishes. In most other respects, Patron View is indistinguishable from In House Registration Mode.
